How students will be assessed:	<p>Component 1: Performance and Choreography (NEA – 60% of GCSE)</p> <p>Students will complete two dance performances</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • two set phrases – Shift and Breathe • one duet or trio <p>Students will choreograph either a complete solo dance or a complete group dance.</p> <p>Component 2: Dance appreciation (1 hour 30 minutes; 40% of GCSE)</p> <p>A mixture of questions based on students' own practice in performance and choreography and the GCSE Dance anthology, assessing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knowledge and understanding of choreographic processes and performing skills • Critical appreciation of own work • Critical appreciation of professional work
