How students will be assessed:	<p>Paper 1: Shakespeare and the 19th-century novel (1 hour 45 minutes; 40% of GCSE)</p> <p>Section A: Shakespeare (Macbeth)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will answer one question on the play, Macbeth. They will be required to write in detail about an extract from the play and then to make links with the whole play.</li> </ul> <p>Section B: pre 1900 Prose ( A Christmas Carol)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will answer one question on the text, A Christmas Carol. They will be required to write in detail about an extract from the novel and then to write about the whole novel.</li> </ul> <p>Paper 2: Modern texts and poetry (2 hours 15 minutes; 60% of GCSE)</p> <p>Section A: Modern texts (An Inspector Calls)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will answer one essay question from a choice of two on their studied modern prose or drama text.</li> </ul> <p>Section B: Poetry (Power and Conflict)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will answer one comparative question on one named poem printed on the paper and one other poem from the Power and Conflict anthology cluster.</li> </ul> <p>Section C: Unseen poetry</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will answer one question on one unseen poem and one question comparing this poem with a second unseen poem.</li> </ul>
