How students will be assessed:	<p>Written Paper: 1 Hour 20 Minutes. This tests the knowledge of the hospitality and catering industry. This makes up 40% of the qualification.</p> <p>The paper is a mix of short and extended questions to be answered based on applied situations. Students will be required to use stimulus material to respond to questions in this paper.</p> <p>Unit 2: Hospitality and Catering in Action.</p> <p>This unit is completed through a non-exam assessment and a brief is supplied by the exam board for students to complete which will include a scenario and several tasks. They will use their experience in research to complete a written report and a practical assessment. This will be internally assessed and externally moderated by the exam board.</p> <p>Students will have 12 hours to complete this non-exam assessment with the guidance of their teacher and regular check points throughout.</p> <p>These non-exam assessments will be based on a choice of tasks released by WJEC annually.</p>

How students will be assessed:	<p>Students study all the following themes on which the assessments are based.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Theme 1: Identity and culture • Theme 2: Local, national, international, and global areas of interest • Theme 3: Current and future study and employment <p>Paper 1: Listening (35 minutes (FT) - 45 minutes (HT); 25% of GCSE)</p> <p>Section A – questions in English, to be answered in English or non-verbally</p> <p>Section B – questions in French, to be answered in French or non-verbally</p> <p>Paper 2: Speaking (7 minutes (FT) – 12 minutes (HT); NEA; 25% of GCSE)</p> <p>Role-play – 15 marks (2 minutes at Foundation Tier; 2 minutes at Higher Tier)</p> <p>Photo card – 15 marks (2 minutes at Foundation Tier; 3 minutes at Higher Tier)</p> <p>General conversation – 30 marks (3–5 minutes at Foundation Tier; 5–7 minutes at Higher Tier)</p> <p><i>NB. The speaking assessments will take place after Easter with your language teacher.</i></p> <p>Paper 3: Reading (45 minutes (FT) – 1 hour (HT); 25% of GCSE)</p> <p>Section A – questions in English, to be answered in English or non-verbally</p> <p>Section B – questions in French, to be answered in French or non-verbally</p> <p>Section C – translation from French into English (a minimum of 35 words at Foundation Tier and 50 words at Higher Tier)</p> <p>Paper 4: Writing (1 hour 5 minutes – 1 hour 20 minutes; 25% of GCSE)</p> <p>In the longer writing tasks, students have a choice of 2 questions from 2 different themes.</p>
