How students will be assessed:	<p>Component 1: Understanding drama (1 hour 45 minutes; 40% of GCSE)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knowledge and understanding of drama and theatre • Study of one set play from a choice of six • Analysis and evaluation of the work of live theatre makers <p>Section A: multiple choice (4 marks)</p> <p>Section B: four questions on a given extract from the set play chosen (44 marks)</p> <p>Section C: one question (from a choice) on the work of theatre makers in a single live theatre production (32 marks)</p> <p>Component 2: Devising drama (practical marked by teacher; 40% of GCSE)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Process of creating devised drama • Performance of devised drama (students may contribute as performer or designer) • Analysis and evaluation of own work <p>Component 3: Texts in practice (practical marked by AQA; 20% of GCSE)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Performance of two extracts from one play (students may contribute as performer or designer)
